## Terms and Conditions

### Release and Indemnity

For the purposes of this form, Pod Squad, their legal representatives, officers, employees and agents are collectively referred to a "Pod Squad"

In consideration of Pod Squad permitting the participant to participate or use goods/services supplied in connection with the swimming coaching, the participant hereby agrees to the following terms and conditions.

- a) The participant agrees at all times during the course of the event to conduct himself or herself in a safe manner (including without limitation following any instructions and safety advice given by instructors/coaches) and take all reasonable measures in order to protect his or her safety as well as the safety of other participants, Pod Squad and its property.
- b) The participants parent or legal guardian consents to Pod Squad delivering medical aid or preventive treatment which may be deemed advisable in the unfettered discretion of first aid trained personal and lifesavers in the event of any personal injury, accident, illness as a result of participation in the coaching.
- c) To the full extent of the law, the participants parent or legal guardian agrees to release, indemnify and hold Pod Squad harmless from all liability, actions, claims and demands of any kind incurred however arising, and whether it is present or future, fixed or unascertained, actual or contingent, from participation by the participant in the coaching, or use of any goods or services by the participant in connection with the coaching, including without limitation, all liability for personal injury, loss or damage to any property and all liability for indirect or consequential loss or damage.

### Other Terms and conditions

Conditions	Important
Make up lessons	We don't offer make up lessons for sickness or for holidays. We are sorry about this, but please understand we only operate 2 days a week and our fees are intentionally lower than other swim schools that provide this service.
Payments	Pod Squad lessons are \$22.50 per ½ hour class, and \$21.00 for our Junior Squads. We only accept Direct Debit, payable on the 1st of every month. You will need to complete our direct debit request form before your child's spot at Pod Squad is confirmed.
Refunds	Despite monthly payments, your commitment to Pod Squad remains on a per-term basis. Therefore, if you withdraw your child mid-way through a term you will be charged until the end of that term. Even if you leave the class during the term, we still have to pay for your teacher, pool hire and insurance. Therefore, we don't offer refunds. In the event your child becomes seriously ill, or breaks a bone etc., please let the office know immediately and we will discuss your case on an individual basis.
Cancelled lessons	If for any reason the pool is closed or lessons are cancelled at the fault of the Swim Centre, you will be give 2 options. 1) A refund for that particular class 2) Credit for following month for the same amount of that class.
Photographs	Pod Squad routinely takes photographs of our enrolled swimmers in and around the pool. Occasionally these photos may appear in marketing materials or on our Facebook page. By signing this form, you are allowing us to use the any photographs of your children in this way.
